Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case of recovery of 260 grams of heroin along with sum of Rs.15 lacs.

Counsel for the petitioner has drawn the attention of this Court to an application, Annexure P-11, which was filed before the trial Court to call for the phone call details of all the members of the police party, in whose presence the recovery was allegedly affected, to show that the call details of all the members of the police party indicate their presence at different places.

So far as the investigating officer Dilbag Singh is concerned, his call details for 21.11.2015 have been withheld. State counsel has submitted that on account of cell phone of said officer, not being in working condition on that day, the call details are not available.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, at this stage, I deem it appropriate to grant concession of bail to the petitioner taking into consideration the period of detention suffered by him and the quantity of heroin recovered from the petitioner being

marginally higher than the prescribed non-commercial quantity.

This petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing said in this order will prejudice any right of the investigating agency in any manner during the course of trial.
