Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50 dated 23.7.2013 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act,1985,PS Sadar Malout,Distt.Sri Muktsar Sahib.

For an alleged recovery of 5 kgs. of poppy husk being non-commercial in quantity the petitioner was released on bail.

It was stated that due to his solitary absence on account of noting of wrong date on 24.2.2016 before the learned trial court his bail bonds have been cancelled and NBWs of arrest have been issued.

Vide order dated 21.3.2016 while issuing notice of motion, petitioner, on surrendering before the trial court within 10 days, was

directed to be released on interim bail.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel submits that pursuant to the said order petitioner has surrendered before the trial court within stipulated time and was released on interim bail.

The said factual position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial court pursuant to the order dated 21.3.2016 passed by this court, is made absolute.
