Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Vijay Kumar in case FIR No.115 dated 26.04.2001 for offence punishable under Section 379 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Division No.8, Rama Mandi, Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Balbir Singh-complainant's car was stolen from outside his house and the petitioner-Vijay Kumar and his brother Ajay Kumar were nominated as accused.

The petitioner was granted bail, however, due to his non appearance before the trial Court he was declared proclaimed offender on 24.12.2002. The other co-accused brother is stated to have died in the year 2004.

After a period of almost 13 years the petitioner states that he is

ready and willing to face trial and, therefore, prays for grant of anticipatory bail.

Counsel for the petitioner heard at length.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
