The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to petitioner, namely, Raj Kumar @ Rajpal in case FIR No.93 dated 23.06.2015 registered under Sections 302, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 306/34 IPC added later on) at Police Station Satnali, District Mahendergarh during pendency of the trial.

On the similar set of allegations, the petitions for grant of regular bail i.e. **Criminal Misc. No.M-39666 of 2015** and **Criminal Misc. No.M-4544 of 2016** filed by co-accused, namely, Ramesh were dismissed as withdrawn on 14.12.2015 and 15.02.2016 respectively and the case of the petitioner is at par with co-accused, namely, Ramesh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition at this stage.
