FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 21.04.2016 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur has been received whereby after recording statements of complainants Balwinder Ram and Sanny Kumar as well as the accused persons namely Paramjit @ Sony, Balbir Ram @ Kaka and Satnam Dass @ Mintu, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a case of version and cross-version, the fact that parties belong to the same very village and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of heinous nature, together with the fact that

compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.232 dated 27.09.2015 registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar under Sections 323/341/148/149 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
