HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed praying for the directions for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, who have entered into matrimony against the wishes of their parents.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI- Gurdip Singh submits that statements of both the petitioners were recorded, wherein, they have stated that they do not have any threat to their life and liberty from the other side and do not need any police protection. Similar statement of respondent No.4, namely, Lakhbir Singh, who is the father of petitioner No.1- Amanpreet Kaur, has also been recorded to the effect that he does not have any objection to the matrimonial alliance.

Statements of both the petitioners as well as respondent No.4, produced in Court today, are taken on record.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the SSP concerned who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
