Impugned in the present revision is the judgment dated 8.1.2016, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali, whereby in appeal, the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 2.5.2015, vide which accused-revisionist was convicted for commission of the offences punishable under Sections 279, 304A IPC, passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali, was upheld. He was sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 6 months under Section 279 IPC. He was also sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 2 years under Section 304-A IPC.

During the course of arguments, the learned counsel for the revisionist presses the revision only on the quantum of sentence.

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I have heard the learned counsel for the revisionist and have also carefully gone through the file.

The learned counsel for the revisionist contends that the revisionist is the first offender. The accident took place on a road when the deceased was trying to cross the road when the traffic light had turned red for the traffic, thereby allowing the pedestrian to cross the road.

Keeping in view that there is no previous conviction against the revisionist and the revisionist is stated to be a young boy, the sentence of rigorous imprisonment for 2 years under Section 304-A IPC is reduced to rigorous imprisonment for 1 year. The sentence passed under Section 279 IPC is maintained.

With the abovesaid modification, the present revision is dismissed.
