The petitioner has preferred this revision petition against the order dated 14.07.2014, passed by the learned Appellate Court, declining the permission to the petitioner to have examined the disputed signatures by any independent agency.

The learned Appellate Court noticed that during the trial one expert witness was examined by the petitioner and one expert witness was examined by the respondent-complainant and came to the conclusion that no useful purpose would be served by examining the disputed signatures by any independent agency.
