Rajan Gupta, J.

Petitioner has impugned order dated 22.9.2015, passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Phillaur, whereby charges have been framed against him under sections 420 and 406 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has not committed any crime. He further submits that after thorough investigation, police declared the petitioner innocent. However, later on an application under section 319 Cr.P.C. was moved by complainant Avtar Singh for summoning petitioner as additional accused and thereafter, he was summoned. Order framing charge is untenable and is liable to be set-aside.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and given careful thought to the facts of the case.

Allegations against the petitioner, who was a Bank Manager in State Bank of India, Rurke Kalan, District Jalandhar, at the relevant
