KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The private respondents No. 2 to 9 have been convicted under Sections 323, 452 read with Sections 149, 148 and 506 IPC and sentenced to undergo various imprisonments ranging from two months to one year by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra, vide judgment of conviction dated 18.5.2013 and order of sentence dated 20.5.2013. In the appeal, the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, vide judgment dated 21.5.2015, released them (private respondents) on probation. The present revision has been filed by Samay Singh (injured).

The notice was issued to the opposite party only on the limited question of grant of adequate compensation to Samay Singh (injured).

CRR 2813 of 2015 (O/M)

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned State counsel, the learned proxy counsel appearing for the learned counsel for private respondents No. 2 to 9 and have also carefully gone through the file.

According to the learned counsel for the complainant-petitioner, Samay Singh (injured) had received five injuries i.e. two on the legs, two on the back and one on the hand. All these injuries were found to be simple in nature.

Considering the nature of injuries, I am of the view that Samay Singh (injured) is entitled to some compensation. Therefore, all the private respondents No. 2 to 9 are ordered to pay jointly Rs. 2,700/- as compensation to Samay Singh (injured) under Section 357 Cr.P.C. The said compensation shall be equally shared by private respondents No. 2 to 9. The present revision is accordingly allowed to the said extent.
