Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate in Court which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners presses the present revision only on the quantum of sentence stating that he does not press on the merits of the revision.

As per prosecution case, Ravi Kumar accused since proclaimed offender, gave datar blow on the upper portion of the wrist of left arm of the complainant, namely, Paramjit Suman. Balwinder Singh gave sword blow which hit on the right little finger of Ashok Kumar. Jeet Singh gave baseball blow which hit on the right side of forehead of Navjot Bala. Injuries attributed to Ravi Kumar, proclaimed

offender were declared grievous in nature. Injury with sword attributed to Balwinder Kumar (real name is Varinder Singh) which hit on the right little finger was also reported as grievous. Defuse swelling on the head of Navjot Bala was found to be superficial.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of injuries attributed to the present petitioners, namely, Jeet Singh and Varinder Singh, their sentences under Sections 326, 452 read with Section 34 IPC is reduced from Rigorous Imprisonment three years to RI for nine months each. Sentence under Section 323 read with Section 34 IPC is also reduced from Rigorous Imprisonment for one year to Rigorous Imprisonment for 6 months each. Remaining part of the sentences are kept intact. All the sentences shall run concurrently.

With aforesaid modification, the revision is dismissed.
