This revision has been filed against the concurrent conviction of the petitioner for the commission of offences under Sections 420 IPC in FIR No.93 dated 15.08.2011 registered at Police Station Lambi whereby the petitioner was convicted and sentenced rigorous imprisonment for 02 years and Rs. 2000/- as fine and in default of payment of fine further under go rigorous imprisonment for two months.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Iqbal Singh Brar, Deputy Superintendent, Central Prison Faridkot on behalf of State has been filed and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel

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opposite. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has undergone actual sentence of 01 year 04 months and 13 days out of the total sentence of 02 years.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is first offender. He further argued that the mother of the petitioner also filed a complaint in the month of July against the complainant.

In my considered opinion, these factors would justify a reduction in the sentence. Consequently, the revision against the conviction is dismissed but the sentence of the petitioner is reduced to 01 year and 06 months.

Revision petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
