Petitioner has filed the instant revision petition against the judgment and order dated 13.06.2016 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar (Annexure P-3), whereby the application filed by the petitioner under Section 389 Cr.P.C. for suspension of sentence was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the said application was dismissed primarily with the observation that the appeal is already at the advance stage and has fixed for arguments. He further submits that the matter is already pending before the lower appellate court and the same is at the final stage.

Considering the fact that the appeal is already at the advance stage of arguments and stated to be fixed for 10.11.2016, lower appellate Court is directed to decide the appeal expeditiously.

With the aforesaid direction, instant petition stands disposed of.
