1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced a copy of an agreement deed dated 24.02.2016 entered between Bathinda Development Authority, Bathinda and petitioner-Osho Prem Dhyan Mandir & Spiritual Research Institute (Regd.), Bathinda, whereupon the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled. A copy of the said agreement is taken on record as Mark 'X'. Para No. 4 of the aforesaid agreement reads as under:

"That any court case or any other claim pending shall be settled in accordance with this agreement and Party No. 2 shall apply in the court regarding withdrawal of CWP No. 4956 of 2008 with immediate effect. Party No. 2 will not file any suit in any court of India against this adjustment of land. Party No. 1

will approve this agreement in court so that case may be settled and withdrawn.”

2. In view of aforesaid Para No. 4 of the said agreement, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition. Learned counsel for the Bathinda Development Authority, Bathinda did not dispute that an agreement dated 24.02.2016 has been entered between the parties and the parties are bound by the terms recorded therein.

3. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
