The petitioner had sought admission in B.Ed. (Regular) Course for the year 2010-2011 against the Kashmiri Migrant quota seat. Direction had also been sought to admit the petitioner provisionally, since the argument was that she was denied admission only on the ground that M.Sc. Biotechnology cannot be treated as a Science stream.

On 14.10.2010 while noting that there was one seat lying vacant and provisional admission was granted to the petitioner, subject to the final outcome and the writ petition was admitted.

The University has also not filed any response, thereafter, contesting the case as such. A period of almost 6 years has expired. The petitioner would have passed out the said course and it would be highly unjust to put the clock back at this stage.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of by

confirming the interim order. The respondent-University shall issue the necessary degree and certificate to the petitioner, in case the same has not been done.
