Application has been filed for condonation of 14 days delay in filing the accompanying revision petition.

Petitioner has preferred the present revision petition against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 18.07.2011 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh, whereby petitioner Usha Rani was convicted under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1981 and was sentenced to undergo Imprisonment for a period of 01 year and to pay compensation of Rs.11 lacs to the complainant. The appeal filed by the petitioner was dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh vide judgment dated 11.08.2014.

A perusal of the file reveals that no one had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner on 21.05.2015, 16.03.2016, 02.08.2016,

15.09.2016 and today itself there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. On last date of hearing the following order was passed:
