RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL)

The only point of friction remaining between the parties is with regard to a sum of Rs.45,658/- due and payable by the State to the petitioner for which Mr. Manuja makes a statement on instructions received from Narenderjit Singh, Superintendent from the office concerned, and present in Court, that the amount will be deposited within six weeks into the pension account of the petitioner with notice of deposit intimated to him. Since the amount was due and payable in the year 2006, the same will earn interest at the rate specified in the Code of Civil Procedure i.e. 6% p.a. The interest element would be added to the principal amount and accordingly the total sum of money worked out be deposited in the above time period. With these directions, the present petition stands disposed of.
