Both the parties along with their respective counsel are present today. They in fact filed a joint petition to convert the original petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 into one under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. We have already allowed the prayer and converted the petition into Section 13-B. The parties have also suffered statements in terms of the compromise arrived at between them. In terms of the compromise it is submitted by the counsel appearing for the petitioner that the Criminal Revision-4134 of 2014 and Criminal Revision-980 of 2015 may be dismissed as withdrawn.
