This revision petition has been filed against the concurrent conviction of the petitioner under Section 326/324 of the IPC and sentence of RI for two years under Section 326 of the IPC, and for one year under Section 324 of the IPC.

As per the custody certificate which had been placed on

record on 11.5.2016, the petitioner had undergone 4 months and 5 days.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the matter has been settled between the parties. This fact has been accepted by learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, as well as by counsel for the complainant/respondent No.2.

In this view of the matter, I deem it appropriate to reduce the sentence of the petitioner to the period which he has already undergone. Ordered accordingly. Consequently, this revision petition is dismissed.
