This petition has been filed against the concurrent conviction of the petitioner under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

On 08.01.2016 the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties. He, thus, prays that matter may be referred to mediation and conciliation centre for exploring the possibility of amicable

settlement of the dispute. Ordered accordingly. The forum shall be at liberty to record compromise. Needful be done within two weeks.

Parties are directed to appear before the said forum on 27.01.2016 and on any other date(s) fixed by the forum.”

Report of the Mediator has been received, as per which the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement.

In the circumstances, even while upholding the conviction of the petitioner, I reduce the sentence of the petitioner to that she has already undergone.

Revision petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
