By way of instant petition, the petitioner has sought setting aside of order dated 28.07.2016, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that total value of 947 bags towards security amount stands deposited by the petitioner in favour of the respondent. However, out of 947 bags only 900 bags have been released. The present petition pertains to the remaining 47 bags. The petitioner further undertakes to make further payment if any due towards petitioner on any other account.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that goods in question are perishable in nature, it is ordered that remaining 47 bags be released in favour of the petitioner forthwith. If on rechecking of the account any amount is found

due towards the petitioner, he shall pay the same within three weeks from such a intimation.
