INDERJIT SINGH, J.

In compliance of order dated 23.02.2016, passed by this Court, the receipt regarding deposit of 15% of the cheque amount has been produced. Same is taken on record.

In view of the compromise effected between the parties and in view of the fact that offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, is compoundable, therefore, the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 28.05.2014 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, and judgment dated 30.10.2015, passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Jalandhar are set aside in view of the lawful composition of the offence.

Petitioner/accused Neeraj Rana is acquitted accordingly and he be set at liberty forthwith, if his custody is not required in connection with any other case.

Accordingly, the instant revision petition stands accepted.
