This petition is filed with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the false/fabricated MLR's prepared by respondent No.4 on 4.5.2013, on the ground that he was on leave on that day.

After notice, respondent No.4 has filed his reply and brought on record the documents which proves that respondent No.4 was on duty on the date when the MLR's were written. Even otherwise, the parties have also entered into a compromise.

Thus, keeping in view the facts and circumstances emerging from the record, I am of the considered opinion that there is no merit in this petition because respondent No.4 has proved by leading cogent evidence that he was on duty at that time when the

MLR's were issued and was not on leave. Consequently, the present petition is hereby dismissed with cost of ₹5000/-.
