This petition has been filed against the concurrent conviction of the petitioner under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC.

The allegation against the petitioner (Lamberdar) was that he alongwith other persons got registered a forged and fabricated sale deed dated 12.07.2012 of Plot No.119-B, Model Village Arjaheri and on the

basis of that sale deed they sold the said plot to the complainant on sale consideration of Rs.29,40,250/-.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel states that there may be some scope for reduction of sentence.

The trial Court sentenced the petitioner to undergo imprisonment of 7 years which was reduced to 4 years by the Appellate Court. In view of the conduct of the petitioner, I see no ground to further reduce the sentence of the petitioner.

Petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
