The petitioner, who was initially admitted in M.B.B.S, was later on not allowed to continue her studies. At that stage, she approached this Court.

On 04.10.2010, this Court as an interim measure directed that the petitioner shall be allowed to attend her classes.

In short reply, dated 06.01.2016, filed by Dr. Darshan Singh Sidhu, Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, it has been stated that petitioner has successfully completed her M.B.B.S course in Nov/Dec 2014.

Learned counsel for the University submitted that in view of the aforesaid development, the prayer made in the petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous. Necessary certificates shall be issued to the petitioner of her successfully completing the M.B.B.S course.
