This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant increments on the post of Registrar after his promotion in view of Punjab Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1988 and also for issuance of direction to the respondents to grant the minimum pay-scale on the post of Registrar as has been granted to his junior, namely, Lachhman Dass.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that during the pendency of this writ petition, the petitioner has been granted benefits vide detailed order dated 2.12.2016 passed by the Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab. He further submits that the petitioner has been granted not only the re-fixation of pay but his pension

has also been revised and other benefits have also been granted to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been denied the arrears of pensionary benefits and interest thereon.

Since the relief sought in the petition has already been granted, the present petition is disposed of. However, for the benefits which have not been granted to the petitioner like interest and arrears, he is at liberty to move a representation within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

In case, such representation is filed by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to take action in accordance with law within a period of one month thereafter and if he is found entitled for the said relief, the same be granted to him within a period of two months thereafter. In case, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
