Ram Lubhaya R/o 4901, Amarkot, P.O. Khalsa College, Amritsar has
come present, who has been identified by his counsel Mr. Veneet
Sharma, who has placed on record duly sworn affidavit of the
complainant to the effect that he entered into a compromise by virtue of
compromise deed Annexure A/1 and states that he has received the
entire money and as such the dispute arising out of the cheque in
question stands fully settled and that he has no objection if the

application is allowed and offences are compounded.

Heard.

Keeping in view that the petitioner has been convicted for commission of offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act and that as per the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is in custody and that the matter has been compromised by virtue of Annexure A/1 and in view of the law laid down in **G. Sivarajan vs. Little flower Kuries and Enterprises Ltd and another 2005(2) DCR 408** and **Ritesh Gupta vs. State of Punjab and another 2009(3) RCR (Criminal) 61** the application is allowed and offences are allowed to be compounded. In view of which Judgement dated 11.6.2012 passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar and judgment dated 30.11.2015 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar are hereby set aside and offences are allowed to be compounded.

Petitioner is set at liberty and he be released from the jail forthwith in case he is not required in any other case.

In view of the same, criminal revision petition No.4974 of 2015 has become infructuous and disposed off as such.
