This is an application for suspension of sentence of the petitioner.

Today learned counsel for the revisionist submits that he challenges the revision only on the quantum of sentence. On his request the revision petition which stands admitted is taken on Board for hearing today.

The present petitioner was convicted for commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468 IPC and sentenced to undergo R.I. for two years each. He was also sentenced to undergo R.I. for one year each for offence punishable under Sections 471 and 411 IPC vide judgment of conviction dated 25.07.2013 and order of conviction dated

29.07.2013 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palwal. The appeal filed by the petitioner was dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Palwal vide judgment dated 27.08.2015. The allegations against the petitioner are that he was found to be in possession of one fake R.C. He was also found in possession of 01 stolen motorcycle. On his disclosure statement, 07 more motorcycles were recovered. In this way, the recovery was of 08 stolen motorcycles.

The learned counsel contends that the sentence awarded for keeping in possession fake registration certificate is quite harsh. After considering the facts and circumstances, the sentence passed under Sections 420, 467, 468 IPC reduced from 02 years to 01 year each.

The remaining part of the sentence awarded under said sections and the sentence awarded under remaining sections is kept intact.

With this modification, revision is partly allowed and partly dismissed.
