Counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that the petitioner was not considered for appointment of English Service Provider in response to the public notice dated 21.6.2012(Annexure P/11) on account of the fact that she did not have English as an elective subject during her graduation.

It is pointed out that a Division Bench in **LPA No.1046 of 2012-Dilpreet Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others** decided on 31.10.2012 (Annexure R/1) has also held that in view of corrigendum issued, English as an elective subject was the requirement.

Accordingly, keeping in view the said binding precedent of the Division Bench in **Dilpreet Singh's case** (supra), there is no scope for interference.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
