Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India challenging the order dated 12.03.2007.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that during the pendency of this petition, the claim of the petitioner was considered and he has been granted disability pension w.e.f. 31.12.2005 vide order dated 20.08.2015. Copy of the order dated 20.08.2015 has been placed on record.
