Petitioner seeks direction for re-admitting him in the B.Tech
1st Year.

The case of the petitioner is that he had done his +2
examination from the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Delhi, in the
Non-Medical stream (Annexure P1). A perusal of the communication
dated 11.11.2011 (Annexure P3) would go on to show that that the
admission was cancelled by respondent No.2-College, on the ground that
the Board from which the petitioner was studying, was not recognized.

The stance of the respondent-University, in the written
statement, is also to the same effect that the certificate given by the Board
is not having an equivalence and accreditation by the Council of Boards of
School Education, as per list attached (Annexure P1/R1). It is the case of
the University that recommendation for cancellation had been sent
immediately on 03.08.2012.

The action of the respondent-University, as such, does not
seem to suffer from any infirmity on account of non-recognition of the
Board on the basis of which the petitioner is claiming admission.

A period of more than 4 years have gone by since then. No interim order was passed in favour of the petitioner. It is apparent that the petitioner has lost interest in the present litigation as there is no appearance on his behalf.

Accordingly, this Court is of the opinion that there is no occasion to find fault in the process resorted by the respondents and the present writ petition is, hereby, dismissed.
