The petitioner has come up in revision against the order dated 10.12.2014 whereby the learned District and Sessions Judge Family Court, Sonipat has awarded interim maintenance of Rs. 8,000/- per month (Rs. 4,000/- each) to the minor children i.e. respondent nos. 2 and 3 from the date of filing of the application i.e. 24.09.2013.

Notice of motion was given to the respondents on 16.01.2015 and the petitioner was directed to make payment of Rs. 10,000/- to respondent no. 1 before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the arrears of maintenance as well as the litigation expenses, as ordered by this Court, has not been paid till date.

Even on third call none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner today. Vide order dated 16.02.2016, petitioner was directed to pay the amount of arrears of maintenance as well as the litigation expenses before the next date of hearing i.e. 04.04.2016. But till date, the arrears have not been

paid to the respondents.

Moreover, the petitioner himself failed to put in appearance.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
