The petitioners have come up in the revision petition against the order dated 25.05.2015. A perusal of the order shows that both the parties had made a joint statement in writing that they have amicably resolved their matrimonial dispute and they had agreed that the respondent shall pay Rs.1500/- per month to the petitioners as maintenance w.e.f. April, 2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has not placed on record any joint statements in writing whereas the respondents had agreed to pay the petitioners a sum of Rs.2500/- as a maintenance. As such, the present revision petitions are dismissed. If any joint statements in writing with aforesaid contents is found correctly, petitioners are at liberty to recall this order at any stage.
