This petition has been filed against the order dated 28.10.2016 passed by JMIC, Amritsar vide which the cross examination of complainant has been recorded as nil.

Learned counsel has argued that matter was fixed for 05.11.2016 for cross examination of the complainant. The petitioner-accused had moved an application for exemption of the petitioner-accused and that was allowed. Learned counsel for the petitioner-accused was under the impression that the matter would now be adjourned but actually the Court had passed a direction that the cross-examination had to be conducted after lunch. This part having been missed by the learned counsel for the petitioner-accused none appeared after lunch and consequently the cross-

examination of the complainant was considered as nil and prays that one opportunity be granted to the petitioner-accused to cross-examine the complainant.

In my opinion, it would be appropriate to grant one opportunity to the petitioner-accused to cross-examine the complainant subject to the payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be paid to the complainant.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
