Copy of FIR No. 140, dated 23.08.2015, under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur has been produced by learned State counsel in Court, same is taken on record.

Heard.

A complaint was received by-post in the office of Chief Justice's Secretariat, which was treated as criminal revision petition. In response to notice issued to the State. Status report by way of affidavit of Gurnam Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police,

Rajasansi, District Amritsar (Rural) has been filed. According to the said report, Gurdev Singh son of the petitioner-Kashmir Kaur was neither arrested and not taken into custody by District Police of Amritsar in any criminal case. However, subsequent thereto, FIR No. 140, dated 23.08.2015, under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, was registered against the petitioner at Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur in which he was arrested.

As per the contents of the FIR, 8 kilograms of heroin has been recovered from the possession of Gurdev Singh, besides the recovery of a sum of Rs.84,70,000/-.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such. However, the petitioner be informed accordingly.
