Learned counsel for respondent-State on instructions from Dr. Shaminder S. Kang, Medical Officer, O/o Director Health and Family Welfare, Punjab submits that as per instructions dated 30.11.2015, the family members of the deceased/missing Government employee were required to file affidavit regarding their being dependent on the deceased.

Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to comply with the requirement of instruction dated 30.11.2015 within a period of one month from today and in case aforesaid formality and other formalities are completed within the stipulated period, the case of the petitioner be considered within a period of one month thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.

In case the petitioner feels aggrieved by the action of the respondents, he is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
