This petition for habeas corpus was filed, stating that Karamjit Kaur, daughter of the petitioner has been illegally detained by respondents No. 3 to 5.

The reply of the State shows that Karamjit Kaur, daughter of the petitioner, had already married with Jagdeep Singh (respondent No. 3). It is further disclosed that FIR No. 78 dated 19.9.2015 under Sections 9 and 10 of Prohibition of Children Marriage Act, 2006, has already been registered at Police Station Nawgraon, District SAS Nagar.

Since the daughter of the petitioner had already married with Jasdeep Singh (respondent No. 3), therefore, it is not a case of illegal detention. Hence, the habeas corpus petition stands dismissed.
