RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL)

No ground is made out for interference in this case because providence would have it that the son of the petitioner for whom she approached court has been enlisted as a Constable in Delhi Police.

Mr. J.S.Bedi, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, appearing for the respondent - State declaims on instructions received from the official of the department present in court that the son is working for the last more than 4 years as a Constable and counsel for the petitioner affirms the fact. If the petitioner could not get a job in Haryana police through the compassionate mode, she should thank her lucky stars that her son has made it by dint of his own merit and without support of the crutches of compassionate appointment, which is the more respectable and upright door to enter government service.

Consequently, the instant petition stands disposed of as no further directions are necessary since the petitioner's son is well settled in life and needs no help from this Court.

However, in case the petitioner feels that she has been harassed by the Government for too long and she has had a hard time to survive and deserves to be compensated by way of damages, she is at liberty to seek her remedies before the civil court, if advised.

Before parting, I may record that the full bench in Krishna Kumari v. State of Haryana, 2012 (2) S.C.T. 736 : 2012 (2) RSJ 473 assembled to deliberate in the petitioner's own case together with a large number of connected petitions, to thrash out the legal issue referred as to whether the date of death of the government servant is the relevant date to apply the policies of the Haryana Government. The Full Bench has been rendered academic for petitioner Krishna Kumari due to her son landing a job for which she came to this Court.
