Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 19.02.2009 passed by respondent no.4 – Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Block Ajnala, District Amritsar whereby petitioner has been stopped to participate as a member panchayat in the panchayat proceedings and further prayer has also been made for directing respondent nos. 1 to 4 to notify the name of the petitioner in Gazette Notification as an elected member of panchayat of Village Ghonewala, Block Ajnala, District Amritsar.

Perusal of the file indicates that present writ petition stands admitted vide order dated 15.03.2011.

Now, respondent no.9 has filed CM-2169-CWP-2016 stating therein that present petition has become infructuous as after filing of the present writ petition, the term of the panchayat has expired and fresh

election has been held in the year 2013.

In view of the fact that fresh election has been held on 26.05.2013, term of the petitioner as member panchayat has expired in 2013, instant writ petition has become infructuous.

For the reasons recorded in CM-2169-CWP-2016, same is allowed. In view of the above, main petition i.e. CWP No. 4353 of 2009 is taken on board and is dismissed as infructuous.
