Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition, however, he prays that he may be allowed to pay the amount of deficient stamp duty, which is approx. Rs.8 lacs, by way of four installments.

Learned State counsel has no objection in this regard.

Consequently, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to deposit the amount of deficient stamp duty and registration charges within a period of four months in four equal installments. In case, the petitioner fails to pay any amount of installments, respondents shall be at liberty to take appropriate actions in accordance with law.
