This is a petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to consider and decide application dated August 12, 2015 (Annexure P-5) moved by the brother of the petitioner to respondent No.3 for pre-mature release of the petitioner, as the petitioner has already undergone more than 19 years of incarceration.

Mr. Amardeep Singh Gill, learned State counsel submits that let a copy of judgment passed by the trial Court be furnished by the petitioner and subsequent thereto, the case of the petitioner shall
