This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to release the petitioner on parole for a period of four weeks for taking care of his family.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that case of the petitioner for release on parole was recommended by Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur. However, no order was passed by respondent No.2, as report from District Magistrate, Shahjahanpur was awaited. He has relied upon judgment reported as ***Tarlochan Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others, 2009 (1) R.C.R. (Criminal) 376*** in support of his plea.

Learned State counsel submits that in view of the fact that report has now been received from the District Magistrate, Shahjahanpur, same shall be considered by the concerned authority and order shall be passed within two weeks from today. Needless to observe that *Tarlochan Singh's case (supra)* shall also be kept in view.
