This habeas corpus petition has been filed by petitioner alleging that her father-in-law had been illegally detained by CIA Staff, Bahadursingh Wala and could be found in illegal custody by the warrant officer. However, he could not be traced by the warrant officer on 15.10.2015. It is alleged that he was later on found in Police Station, Lehra under security proceedings on 28.10.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that father-in-law of the petitioner has been illegally detained for a period of 18 days. The detinue is present in the Court today.

In view of the above, the petition has already outlived its utility the detinue having already been released. The petition is disposed of having rendered infructuous. However, it will be open to the detinue or the petitioner to avail any remedy, in accordance with law, by establishing the illegal detention.
