This petition has been received in the Chief Justice's Secretariat, which has been treated as Criminal Writ Petition to be taken on judicial side. Through this petition, petitioner Jaspal Singh has alleged that on 9.11.2015 at about 3 O' clock, some employees of the police came in private vehicle bearing registration No.PB-10-DN-0663 and took Amritpal Singh away with them forcibly. It has further been alleged that when he tried to stop them, then they took out cash amounting to ₹ 50,000/- and about ten tolas of gold from the almirah lying in his house.

In pursuance to the notice, the matter was enquired into by the Incharge of concerned Police Post. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner was approached to get recorded his statement and he made the statement to the effect that on 9.11.2015, his son Amritpal Singh had left his house along with his friends

but on the basis of some suspicion, he lodged complaint by post in this Court. Since his son has returned to the house, he has no grudge against any person and further that he does not intend to proceed with the complaint filed by him in this Court.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, this petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
