This is an application for condonation of delay of 2588 days in filing the revision petition on the ground of pendency of petition bearing No. CRM-M-17100-2012 which was disposed of with liberty to seek remedy as per law.

For the reason mentioned above, the same is allowed and delay of 2588 days in filing the revision petition is condoned.

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This revision has been filed against the impugned order dated 20.10.2008 whereby complaint under Section 195 Cr.P.C filed by the petitioner against the private respondents has been dismissed.

It is not disputed that the petitioner and the private respondents

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are members of the Freemasons and the dispute is with regard to the various elective office(s) of the society.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly accepted that civil litigations between the parties in respect of these very disputes has come to an end but has not been finalized.

In these circumstances, I deem it appropriate to not proceed further in the matter. I find that one of the reason for dismissing the complaint was that the matter was of civil nature. I see no reason to take different view.

Petition stands dismissed.
