The present petition was registered on the basis of a complaint made by Hardeep Kaur wife of Sukhbir Singh, resident of village Mule Chakk, Post Office Fatehpur, Tehsil and District Amritsar, which was addressed to Hon'ble the Chief Justice of this Court.

It is averred in the complaint that son of the petitioner, namely, Ramandeep Singh was posted as Data Entry Operator in the account branch of the Shiromani Gurudwara Parbhandak Dharam Parchar Committee. On 23.10.2015, he tendered his resignation to Avtar Singh Makkar, President of Shiromani Committee out of resentment after getting much emotional due to Beadbi of "Guru Granth Sahib". As a result thereupon, Punjab police started harassing him without any reason with a threat that they would implicate

him in some false case.

Reply by way of affidavit of Amandeep Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central Amritsar has been filed, which is taken on record. As per said reply, there is FIR No.198 dated 16.11.2015 under Sections 295, 427, 511, 506, 148, 149 and 153-A IPC as well as Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Kotwali, Amritsar City against Ramandeep Singh, who is son of the petitioner. During the course of investigation of this case and while looking into the footage of CCTV cameras installed in the periphery of the Golden Temple, Ramandeep Singh son of the petitioner was identified among those unknown persons against whom the instant FIR was registered. Accordingly, Ramandeep Singh was also nominated as an accused in the case.

Considering the fact that the aforesaid FIR has been registered against Ramandeep Singh son of the petitioner and the matter is under investigation with the police, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of accordingly.
