This is an application moved under Section 389 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for suspension of sentence by Pavittar Singh-applicant/petitioner, during pendency of the revision petition.

Learned counsel for the applicant contends that the applicant has already undergone 06 months and 02 days out of the total substantive sentence of rigorous imprisonment for 01 year.

Learned State counsel has furnished custody certificate, which is taken on record.

A glance at the custody certificate reveals that out of the total substantive sentence of rigorous imprisonment for 01 year, applicant/petitioner has already undergone actual sentence of 06 months and 02 days.

The revision petition has already been admitted and there is no other case either pending or disposed of against the applicant of the similar nature.

Taking into consideration all these aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, application is allowed and sentence imposed upon applicant-petitioner, Pavittar Singh, shall stand suspended, during the pendency of revision petition, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds as per the satisfaction of concerned Id. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
