The present petition was registered on the basis of an application made by the petitioner, namely, Neelam wife of Ramesh, resident of Vidyanand Colony, Uggra Kheri, Panipat.

The allegation in the application is that Nitesh Kumar has taken away her daughter Suman on the pretext of getting work in the factory and when Suman did not return in the evening, the petitioner along with her family members started for her search. The matter was reported to the police.

Learned State counsel has filed the copy of statement made by

the girl, namely, Suman wherein it is mentioned that Suman is major and she has gone with Nitesh as per her own wish. Copy of said statement is taken on record. The said statement was made by Suman under Section 164 Cr.PC before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat on 5.8.2015.

In view of the above, no order is required to be passed in the present petition and the same is disposed of as such.
