JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been preferred by Kamalpreet Kaur-petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus by levelling allegations that her husband has been illegal detained by the respondents No.2 to 6.

Vide order dated December 19, 2015, Warrant Officer was appointed to visit the place and to trace out the whereabouts of the detenue.

In compliance of the said order, Vijay Kumar Gupta was appointed as Warrant Officer. He has visited the

premises of CIA-II but Harjeet Singh was not found there. On his asking, the petitioner also did not divulge any other place to be searched to trace the alleged detainee.

Reply by way of affidavit of Pirthe Pal Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (Investigation), Ludhiana has been filed by the respondents, according to which, the allegations leveled in the petition have been refuted.

In view of the report submitted by the Warrant Officer and contents mentioned in the reply, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as such.
