The petitioner has come up in the revision petition against the order dated 07.04.2016 whereby, on an application made under Section 127 Cr.P.C. maintenance has been awarded to the respondents at Rs.7,000/- as per award dated 05.10.2013 has been enhanced to Rs.9,000/- per month with effect from the date of filing of the petition i.e. 21.05.2015.

The facts not in dispute are that the respondent-wife is residing in a separate portion and the children are staying with the petitioner initially when the application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. was filed. In this petition, petitioner had placed on record certain documents i.e. Ex. R2 to Ex.R7 and a copy of judgment dated 6.07.2013 passed by the that Court 6.07.2013 as Ex.R18 and a copy of order dated 26.03.2015 as Ex.R9, after taking into consideration of all the documents, the learned Family Court has come to the conclusion that the petitioner is not withholding any information about his own income or earnings in his written statement as well as while deposing before the Court. The petitioner had not filed any written statement therein as the matter had been

compromised on 05.10.2013.

Respondent had pleaded that the petitioner was earning Rs.3 Lacs per month, he had a luxurious car and had rental income of Rs.55,000/- and owned 4-5 plots and she is residing alone in a separate portion and maintaining herself completely and she has to incur a heavy amount on medication as she is suffering from various illnesses.

In view of the above and considering the fact that she is residing alone and suffering from various illness, the present petition seeking setting aside the order dated 07.04.2016 passed by the learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurgaon, is dismissed as such.
